REFLECTION FOR FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: Fr Emile

In the Gospel today, Jesus asks us to make our home in Him. The Eucharist, the Sacraments, the Bible, the Rosary, are all some of the ways in which we can make our home in Jesus. There are many distractions in our world also inviting us to make our 'home' in them, but if we do that, our branch will wither and we will not bear fruit. We are all called to make our Home in Jesus. He alone is the Way, the Truth and the Life. And, when we make our Home in Jesus, we will bear fruit. Jesus said, "A branch cannot bear fruit by itself but must remain part of the vine".

It's not just a question of making our home in Jesus because it feels good. As Jesus tells us in the Gospel, "whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears much fruit, for cut off from me you can do nothing.' Are we bearing fruit for the Kingdom of God? Is our Christian love real and active, something that inspires others? By opening the door of our heart, inviting Jesus in, every moment of every day, the 'fruit supply' will be limitless.
