REFLECTION FOR FORTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: Fr Carlo

What is your image of God?

Is your god a strict lawgiver who imposes difficult rules and punishes those who fail to follow? Is your god a divine puppeteer who controls every action of each person, disregarding and disrespecting human freedom? Is your god a celestial judge policing humanity by granting merits or demerits based on human actions?

You may be nodding your head at this moment. Unfortunately, these are incomplete, or even wrong, images of God. We may have learned these images of God from our catechists, parents, or even teachers. This may also be a projection to God of our personal images of our own parents who may have been strict and conditional in their way of loving us. Finally, these incomplete images may simply be an unfinished understanding of God based on the Old Testament.

With Jesus Christ, we are given the complete image of who God is. In our Gospel today, He says that He is the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep. The image of the Good Shepherd is an image of a God who is unconditional in His loving. He searches for those who are lost and brings them back to the fold. He leads them to good pastures and keeps them away from harm. Even if they walk in a dark valley, they will not be afraid for the Shepherd is with them at their side.

Jesus as the Good Shepherd is different from our old images of God as a strict lawgiver, divine puppeteer, and celestial judge. After all, Jesus is the incarnate God.

Lord, You are my Good Shepherd. With You, there is nothing I shall want. Thank You for finding me when I am lost. Thank You for laying down Your life for me.
