REFLECTION FOR THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT : Fr Carlo

When Pope Francis came for a pastoral visit to the Philippines, he had an evening with families at the Mall of Asia Arena. He gave an animated talk about faith and family, and he touched on St. Joseph as an exemplar. He said that families now face varied issues and concerns, and these often press us for some answers and plans of action. He said that to move with faith in those moments is to start with prayer. Prayer, however, is not just speaking to God. Rather, it is also giving space and time for God to tell us what He wants. The image of the sleeping St. Joseph shows us what prayer means: to sleep and allow God to speak to us in a dream. Pope Francis shared that he has an image of the sleeping saint on his desk at the Vatican. On many occasions, he said he would slip a paper under it that contains lists of issues or a letter that concerns him.



Our Gospel today is the biblical basis of Pope Francis' devotion to the Sleeping St. Joseph. Let us take note, though, that the narrative mentions certain important dispositions that Joseph had as he slept. Joseph slept not to escape but to seek God's guidance for his resolution and action regarding Mary's mysterious pregnancy. Escapism is never a godly resolution.

Joseph wanted to practice justice, to do what is right according to God's law and human propriety. We should never ask God to enlighten us on options that are unjust. God cannot contradict Himself.

Joseph woke up and did as the angel commanded him. We listen, we decide, we act. It is not good to allow ourselves to be dragged by events. When the divine instruction is clear, our call of faith is to act with great trust.

So the Sleeping St. Joseph did not sleep forever. Neither did he sleep longer than necessary. The Sleeping St. Joseph is also St. Joseph the Worker.

Lord, help me to trust You with all my concerns. Guide me with Your wisdom. Amen.


