REFLECTION FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME : Fr Carlo

A man once stood at a busy crossroads, watching hundreds of people pass by every day. Most faces blended together, but one morning he noticed someone different—not because of noise or attention, but because of a quiet presence that carried purpose. That moment of recognition changed how he understood the world around him.

John the Baptist experiences a similar moment. Seeing Jesus approach, he names him the Lamb of God, the one who takes away the sin of the world. John admits that he did not fully know who Jesus was at first; understanding came through obedience and attentiveness to the Spirit. His role was not to draw attention to himself, but to point clearly and faithfully to Christ. This passage reminds us that God often reveals himself not all at once, but through watching, listening, and trusting.



Lord, open our eyes to see You at work around us. Give us attentive hearts, like John the Baptist, willing to listen to Your Spirit and point others toward You. Help us trust Your revelation even when we do not fully understand. Amen.


