REFLECTION FOR THE SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: Fr Carlo

Valentine's is still in the air. Surely, we all have our own love stories and no matter how or where they may have led or ended, we still continue to love. Today, Jesus wants us to see everyone and everything in His context of love by citing three commandments, that is, forbidding murder, adultery, and oaths.

A law has meaning and worth when the dignity of a person is upheld. This is why Jesus mentioned first the fifth commandment in His sermon on the mount: "You shall not kill." Jesus skipped Commandments 1 to 4 in His sermon on the mount not because they are unimportant but because the fifth commandment expresses the inviolability of life. When we truly love, we do not simply give up on anyone, whether a baby in the womb, an aged or bedridden sick person, or a criminal languishing in jail. Love is always life-giving.



In preserving and respecting life, we have to examine our hearts to see how we truly regard one another: "You shall not commit adultery." Jesus is telling us that in reality, there is no difference between man and woman as the same duties bind the one with the other in marriage or even in simple relationships. When we love, we love the total person and not just a part of him or her.

Finally, Jesus reminds us also to love truly in word and in deed: "But I say to you, do not swear at all." Of God's creations, we humans are the only ones gifted with the ability to communicate intelligibly which is, in fact, a sharing in God's mighty powers. When God created everything, He simply spoke and they came to be. Such is the power of words.

Lord Jesus, help us use our freedom wisely by choosing what is good, choosing life, choosing to love always in You. Open our hearts to welcome God's wisdom that the world could neither understand nor accept because it is You, who is the perfect embodiment of His love for us. You are the law of love we must follow. Amen.


